

RALEIGH, Dec. 18.—Pensions and other benefits for war veter-ans and their families to the ag-gregate of \$132,609 were secured during November by the Vcterans' Service Division of the State Le-partment of Labor, Commissioner Forrest H. Shuford has announc-ed.
