## **Farmers Find** Difference In **Dusted Peanuts**

Winton.—Experiments on the farms of four Hertford county farmers in dusting peanuts to prevent leaf spot showed an average increase an acre over undusted peanuts of 634 pounds.

The four farmers are T. D. Chitty of Murfreesboro, J. R. Phelps of Aulander, L. C. Dilday and L. S. Jernigan of Ahoskie.

In the experiment yields were taken from an acre of dusted peanuts and an acre of undusted peanuts. The results on each of the four farms were as follows: T. D. Chitty, 2,348 pounds an acre from dusted peanuts, 1,503 pounds an acre from undusted, difference of 845 pounds; L. C. Dilday, 2,142 pounds from dusted, 1,491 pounds from undusted, difference of 651 pounds; L. S. Jernigan, 1,824 pounds from dusted, 1,399 pounds from undusted, difference of 425 pounds; J. R. Phelps, 1,562 pounds from dusted, 948 pounds from undusted, difference of 614 pounds.

The cost of dusting is about \$3 per acre which makes approximately \$60 on acre profit, according to J. W. Ballentine, county
