CONTEST OVER NANCE WILL PUT OFF TILL NEXT COURT

The will case of the late Terrell H. Nance, although on the Superior court docket for trial Monday, was not reached and goes over to the next term of court.

The will filed for probate shows that it was executed on the 28th day of June, 1909, with C. T. Martin and G. A. Frye as witnesses. Mr. Nance died on the 23rd of May, 1915, and announcement was made at the burial that he had left his property to H. C. Pace, and this caused comment at the time.

By construing the term "natural life" to mean single life the executor lays claim to the property. In other words, she was not to marry, they contended. But this can not be established even if it was material for Mr. Nance lived at the home of his niece seven months after she was married, and was not the kind of man who would live at any one's home he disliked.

Miss Nance (now Mrs. Murray) lived with her Uncle Terrell five years during which time she sewed and placed her earnings with his and together they invested in property and bonds. And it was for the purpose of selling her about their joint investments and the matter of the will that he visited her after her marriage.

The fact that counsel from outside the county has been brought into the suit indicates a long drawn battle, notwithstanding the assurance of her uncle that the executor would see that she got the property without any suit whatever.

The will reads as follows: State of North Carolina, Rockingham County.

I, T. H. Nance, of the aforesaid county and State, being of sound mind, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this my last will and testament:

1. My executor hereinafter named shall give my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my friends and relatives and pay all funeral expenses together with all my just debts out of the first monies which may come into his hands belonging to my estate.

2. I give and devise to my niece, Carrie Nance, daughter of J. H. Nance of Coffee, Illinois, after all just and honest debts are paid the balance of my entire estate so long as she maintains her natural life and make her home in Illinois or here in Rockingham county, State of North Carolina; otherwise I give my entire estate after all my debts are paid to my executor.

3. In case I should live longer than my niece, Carrie Nance, I give my entire estate after all just debts are paid to my executor.

4. My executor shall in case of my sickness see that I am well cared for.

5. I hereby constitute and appoint my truly friend H. C. Pace, of the county of Rockingham, State of North Carolina, my lawful executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof, hereby evoking and declaring utterly void all other wills and testament by me heretofore made.

H. Nance, do hereunto set my hand and seal this the 28th day of June, 1909.
