On the 8th day of November 1916, the following resolution was unanimously adopted: Be it ordered by the Board of Commissioners of the town of Reidsville, North Carolina, that whereas A. Wilkinson, Clerk of this Board, has submitted to the Board a petition of a majority of the abutting property owners on the following described local improvement district, viz: Beginning at the intersection of East Market street and Lawsonville Avenue and running East with said Lawsonville Avenue to the intersection of Barnes Street with Lawsonville Avenue at C. W. Jackson's corner, (which is hereby made a local improvement district as contemplated in Chapter 65 P. L. North Carolina 1915) and has lodged his certificate showing the sufficiency of said petition in all respects as required by Chapter 5 P. L. North Carolina, 1915. Therefore it is hereby resolved that the local street improvement to wit: the paving of all said local improvement district composed of said Montgomery with sheet asphalt on a concrete base as per plans and specifications to be filed by a competent engineer and approved by this Board. It is further ordered that owners of all property abutting on said streets and within said local improvement district, to be paved, shall connect their several premises with water mains and sewer pipes, said connections to be made in accordance with ordinance on sewers and water connections, located in the said local improvement district adjacent to their several premises in the manner herein prescribed, viz They shall cause said connections to be made or the Board of Commissioners will cause said connections to be made and the cost thereof shall be specially assessed against the particular lot or parcel of land for is connection with which it was made. It is further ordered that the owners of property abutting on said streets to be paved, within said local improvement district, shall be assessed upon said abutting property one-half of the cost of said paving of said streets, said assessments shall be payable in ten equal installments, but said assessments shall bear six per cent interest per annum from assessment roll. date of the confirmation of the as- M.
