

MINUTES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MONDAY MARCH 5, 1917

Board met pursuant to adjournment with the following members present: R. E. Wall, Chairman, J. A. Johnson, L. W. Matthews, W. A. Webster, and J. S. Wells.

On motion John D. Martin is allowed to list in Mayo Township without cost duplicate of 1915.

On motion Willie McGehee is allowed \$1.50 per month for three months. J. H. Moore to furnish same.

On motion the allowance of Mrs. J. J. Settles is increased to \$2.50 per month on account of her extreme age.

On motion the allowance of Will Martin is increased to \$2.50 per month.

On motion Smith Moore is allowed \$1.50 per month for three months. A. D. Weil to furnish same.

On motion John D. Strader is exempt from road duty and poll tax unrevoked, also rebated for 1915 on account of permanent disability.

On motion Geo. W. Estes and J. S. Carter County Home keeper are requested to furnish the board with a complete inventory of all property belonging to the Road and County Home respectively.

MONDAY MARCH 19, 1917

Board met pursuant to adjournment with the following members present: R. E. Wall, Chairman, W. A. Johnson, L. W. Matthews, W. A. Webster and J. S. Wells.

On motion Superintendent of Roads is instructed to build a sixteen foot road from the macadam road near Jim Moore's to a point on the sand clay road near Will Wall's provided rights of way are given.

On motion S. B. Dameron is ordered to make a survey of road from Reidsville via Harrison's cross roads and French's store to the new bridge near Draper and report his findings to the Board at their next meeting.

On motion an election is ordered to be held on the first Tuesday in May for the purpose of electing a Judge for the Recorder's Court in Leaksville Township, as per Chapter 415 Public Laws of North Carolina for 1915.

On motion the Clerk of the Board is allowed to list land belonging to J. N. Watt and Tom Wright bought of Aaron Settle in Ruffin Township, it appearing no title has been listed for four years.

On motion the Est. of Yorke Gallier is allowed to list one lot in Stoneville \$210.00.

On motion it is ordered that on account of the high price of all food products the jailer is allowed forty cents per day for boarding prisoners up to and including six, over six thirty-five cents per day.

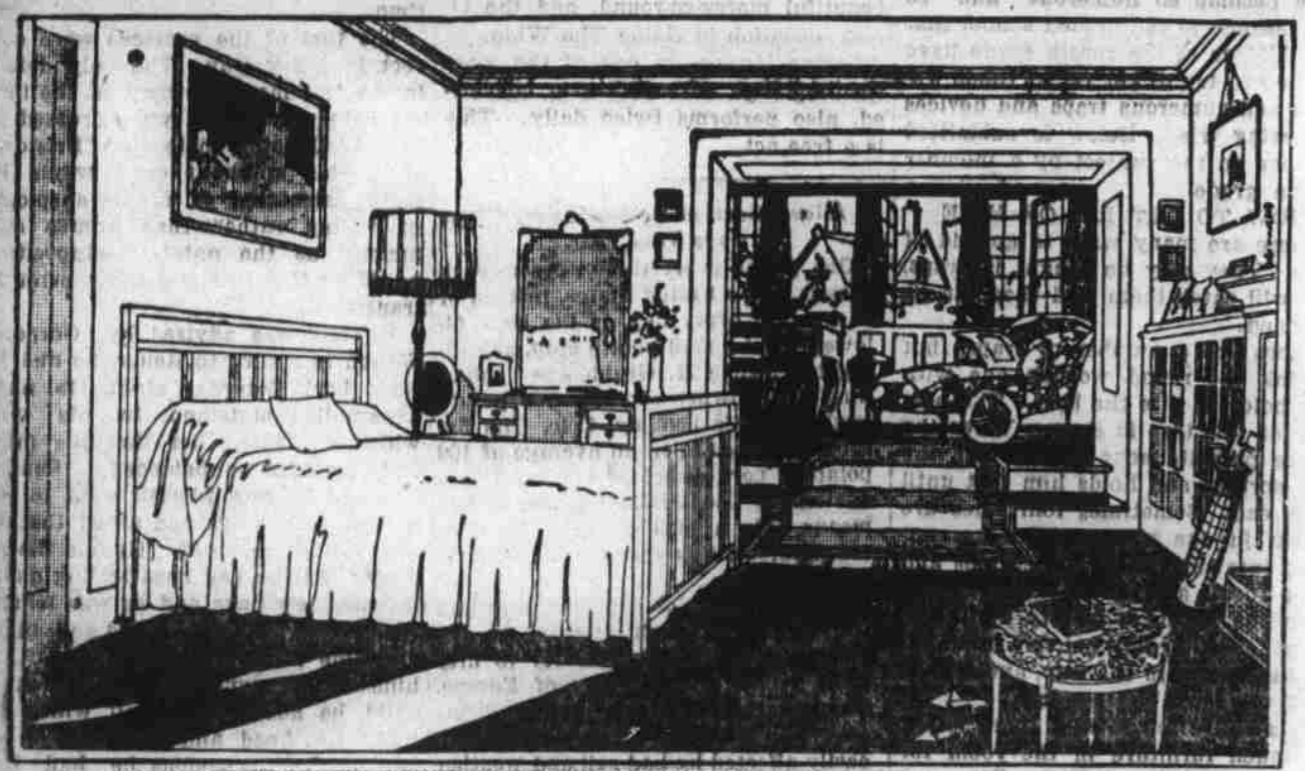
