On motion A. R. Dehart is allowed to list in Leaksville Township as follows: One poll, he being 26 years of age, one horse \$70.

Pending the issuance of the bonds ordered January 23, 1917, it is hereby ordered:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ROCKINGHAM COUNTY:

That 1 note of Rockingham County North Carolina in the sum of Thirty thousand (\$30,000) Dollars, dated May 14, 1917, due six months after date and bearing interest from date at the rate of 5 1/2 per cent per annum payable semi-annually, both interest and principal payable to the bearer at the Importers & Traders National Bank of the City of New York in anticipation of taxes to be collected within that period from the tax poll of 1916 and 1917 and said note be sold or hypothecated by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Rockingham, North Carolina and the proceeds thereof turned into the general fund of said County of Rockingham, and

Be it Further Resolved that the full faith and credit of Rockingham County, North Carolina be pledged to payment of said note at maturity: I. J. P. McMichael, Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of Rockingham County, do hereby certify that the foregoing resolution is a true record of the proceedings of the County.

Interest payable at maturity, the Board of Commissioners of Rockingham County North Carolina promises to pay to the Bearer hereof at the Bank of the City of New York the sum of \$30,000, thirty thousand dollars and interest as specified.

This note is given for money borrowed in anticipation of taxes and is a direct obligation of the Board of Commissioners of Rockingham County and is hereby certified that every necessary formality has been fully complied with and that this note is within every debt and other limit prescribed by law by the Board of Commissioners of Rockingham County, State of North Carolina.

In witness whereof said Board of Commissioners of the County of Rockingham has caused these presents to be signed in its name by its Chairman, attested by its Clerk and its corporate seal to be affixed, all by order of the Board of County Commissioners this day and year first above written.
