

MANY PERSONS CLAIMED EXEMPTION FROM DRAFT

OTHER REGISTRANTS MAY BE EXAMINED

TWO HUNDRED AND NINE OUT OF THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-TY SIX ASK TO BE EXEMPTED FOR VARIOUS REASONS FROM THE SELECTIVE DRAFT.

If all exemptions claims in this county are granted, another batch of registrants will be called for examination. Of the 336 examined last week 81 failed to pass the physical examination, and 209 filed claims for exemption. A few failed to appear for examination. So it is seen that this would leave less than 40 toward completing the county's quota of 167.
