**SAYS FRANCE MUST PAY**

America's answer to France's second attempt at postponement of the December 15 war debt payment was a quite definite "no," but its wording was interpreted in Paris as containing "possibilities of an agreement."

**22 BELIEVED KILLED IN MINE**

Four bodies were removed Friday night from the Zero mine of the Harlan Fuel company at Yancy, Ky. Rescue workers had little hope 18 other men reported in the shaft would be recovered alive.

**LAYING PLANS FOR BATTLE**

Gathering their forces in Washington during the midst of the wet drive for beer, light wines and repeal, the Anti-Saloon League of America, in a specially-called national convention at the Raleigh hotel Friday, launched into an intensive study of ways and means to "repeal" of the 18th amendment.

**KILLED IN AUTO-TRAIN WRECK**

Miss August Phillips, 19, was killed Sunday and five companions on an auto ride injured slightly when their car ran into a Norfolk-Southern passenger train at a grade crossing near Washington, N. C. Miss Phillips suffered a fracture of the skull and died instantly.

**PROSPERITY DEPENDS ON DEBT SETTLEMENT**

Restoration of prosperity to the cotton belt and a revival of the buying power of the Southern States were described in statements by Will L. Clayton and Clarence Onley, cotton authorities, Sunday, as resting directly upon a solution of the war debts problem.

**FATALLY INJURED**

Mrs. Robbie McAulay Harris, 34, of Statesville, was instantly killed on the Albemarle-Salisbury highway near Albemarle late Sunday night when an automobile skidded on the slippery pavement and overturned. Mrs. Harris' head was crushed.

**APPROVE LOAN**

The Reconstruction Finance Corporation Monday agreed to lend the City of Winston-Salem \$180,000 for use in connection with sewer improvements, the loan to be repaid within 18 years.

**WANTS ROOSEVELT TO PUNISH SOUTH**

A resolution requesting President-elect Roosevelt to "withhold any federal patronage in the Southern States until such states readjust their taxes," was adopted by the Southern Truckmen's Association which held its convention in New Orleans Sunday.

**LOSES SIX SONS**

Three double graves at Lonesome Valley, Tenn., Sunday received the bodies of the six sons of J. N. Masengill, among 23 miners killed in an explosion in Zero mine at Yancy, Ky., Friday.

**WOMEN ATTACK WETS**

Opposition to modification of the Volstead law was presented Monday to the House ways and means committee by a dozen women prominent in the prohibition cause. At the same time the Senate Judiciary committee began a study of proposals to repeal the Eighteenth Amendment with storm signals of a sharp controversy over banning the saloon hoisted high.

**NOMINATED VICE PRESIDENT**

Dr. Louis Round Wilson, for 30 years librarian at the University of North Carolina, who resigned last summer to become head of the graduate library school at the University of Chicago, Monday was nominated vice-president of the Chapel Hill unit of the Greater University by a committee of five trustees appointed last November by Governor Gardner.

**WILL HANG WOMAN**

Winnie Ruth Judd's last chance for life before the justice of Arizona was lost Monday when the state supreme court ordered the convicted murderess to be hanged Friday, February 17, 1933, and denied her appeal.

**CALLS 'EM SOREHEADS**

Following a speech by Captain Luther Barbour in which he denounced as "soreheads" General Pershing, Alfred E. Smith and Admiral Richard E. Byrd, members of the National Economy League seeking to reduce federal appropriations for war veterans, the Durham post of the American Legion Monday night voted opposition to the league's activities.
