

JUDGE CONTINUES RESTRAINING ORDER

Suit Pending In Surry Court To Oust Primitive Baptist Preacher

In a hearing at the Forsyth county courthouse at Winston-Salem last Thursday, Judge John H. Clement ordered the restraining order against Elder G. C. Dunbar, restraining him from holding services in the Union Primitive Baptist church of this county, continued until the case is heard in Surry superior court.

The hearing was held on a petition to dismiss the restraining order originally entered in the case.

It was sometime ago that charges were filed in Surry superior court asking a permanent restraining order to prevent Elder Dunbar from holding services in the Union Primitive Baptist church. The suit grew out of a church conference in which Elder Dunbar, then assistant pastor of the church, was excluded as a member of the congregation, his license to preach revoked and ordered not to hold further services in the church. The restraining order, originally, was signed since Elder Dunbar is alleged to have persisted in holding services in the church.

Charges preferred against Elder Dunbar were to the effect that he had caused a disturbance and disorder in the church for sometime. He was alleged by the church to have withdrawn from fellowship with the church association and from all the 18 churches of the association with the exception of two, the State Road and Laurel Springs Primitive Baptist churches.

The suit pending in Surry superior court was brought by Elder J. W. Creed, the regular pastor of the church, on behalf of the alleged majority of the congregation.

COUNTIES TO CARE FOR THEIR NEEDY

ERA Relief Administration To Provide Job For Employables

Beginning January 1, the North Carolina Emergency Relief administration will discontinue relief to unemployables, it was learned from a dispatch sent out from Raleigh by Mrs. Thomas O'Berry, state relief administrator. These charges, heretofore provided with food and clothing by the relief administration, will be turned over to county, municipal and community agencies.

This is termed one of the steps to be taken by the national administration to reduce the burden of relief and let states, counties and municipalities care for their own unfortunates.

The ERA, however, will continue its activities in giving aid to families in which there are employable persons. If there is one person in a family who is able to work that family will still be entitled to relief from the ERA provided the case worker who investigates the case finds it to be a fact that that person is able and willing to work and cannot find employment.
