HOUSING . . 200 years ago I have been lately looking into the history of housing, in Europe and America. From the movies and romantic historical novels it is easy to get the impression that our ancestors all lived in beauti-ful "Colonial" houses or magnifi-cent castles and manor houses. The ordinary house was built by planting posts in the ground, weaving saplings between the posts, and filling in the walls with clay. The roof was of rushes piled in a thick layer on poles, and kept from blowing away by heavy stones. were no floors, only beaten earth, and no windows, in the homes of most of our ancestors of 500 years ago.
