THE INDIANS.

Dispatch From Gen. Miles Relative to the Situation - The Forces Under Command of Gen. Miles.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 5. - Gen. Schofield this morning received the following telegram from Gen. Miles, dated Pine Ridge, January 2d:

The telegram last night should read three hundred people instead of four hundred. There is a report from the Indian camp this morning that Red Cloud and Little Wound has determined to come in with their followers.

The force now on the field under command of Gen. Miles is composed of the following regiments: First, Sixth, Seventh, (eight companies), and the Ninth Cavalry; one company of the First Artillery, Company E; one company of the Fourth Artillery, Company F; and the First, Second, Third, Seventh, Eighth, Twelfth, Sixteenth, Seventeenth, Twentieth, Twenty-first, Twenty-second, and Twenty-fifth Infantry, making in all one hundred and fifty-one companies.

Scouts who have returned from other hostile camps, however, bring anything but reassuring reports. The Indians will not listen to peace propositions. A small detachment of troops were sent to the scene of Monday's battle on Wounded Knee, where many bodies of Indians slain remain yet.
