



WASHINGTON, Feb. 18.-Admiral Porter died suddehly at 8:15 o'clock this morning at his residence, No. 714 H street. His death resulted from fatty degeneration of the heart, which relentless disease asserted its fatal clutch upon him at Newport, R.
