GREAT RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION.

Though we have already more miles of railway than all the rest of the world combined, railroad construction is proceeding at a greater rate than it has gone for several years past.

The Railway Age is a reliable and conservative authority on this subject. At the beginning of last year it predicted that something over 4,000 miles of railway would be built in 1899. The actual figure were 4,588 miles.

We are therefore confident that the estimate of The Railway Age for this year may be relied upon as approximately correct:

It gives the following summary of new railroads, miles projected and already under construction:

South Atlantic States.....	117 9,752
Gulf and Miss. Val. States.....	113 6,786

Commenting on this table The Railway Age said:

"We do not undertake to say that all of this mileage will be built; in fact, it is certain that much of it never will be. It is an easy matter to take out a charter for a new company, but it is quite another thing to raise the money with which to build the road. Many of the charters cover practically parallel lines, and it is impossible to tell which stand the best show of being carried to completion. Some will never get beyond the preliminary stage, while others will make some surveys and probably do a little grading, with the hope of securing local aid and then disappear from public notice. . . . If the same ratio be applied to 1900 (as to 1899) there will be 5,000 miles of road completed during the current year, and it will not be surprising if the figure exceeds that amount."

In spite of the fact that steel rails have about doubled and that everything else necessary to railway construction has gone up very much, it is certain that the new railroad mileage this year will exceed that of any single year since 1890.

This is one of the most convincing proofs of the prosperity of the country and the confidence of capital in its future development.

It will be seen that a great deal more than half the projected mileage is in the South.

The South is by far the most hopeful section of the country and the one that is making the most rapid progress.
