
Atlanta has a mayor and also a city council, and one of the duties of the latter consists in periodically demanding the resignation of the former, on one pretence or another. Sometimes, the council says, he consults the record of the governors of North Carolina and South Carolina too frequently, and sometimes it says he is not discriminating enough in his personal visits inside the gates, so to speak, of his own city, which is, of course, a reflection to some extent upon the city; and sometimes it simply says he has been guilty of conduct unbecoming a gentleman, although gentlemen have, as a rule, been abolished throughout the republic, their places having been taken by plain men.

But whatever the alleged cause be, it fails to find a response in the executive breast of a city that is very bumptious even with a census staring it in the face. To the latest demand of this remarkable council Mayor Woodward thus replies: "I have given your request for my resignation careful and conscientious consideration and I am convinced that the public interest makes it my duty to continue to fill the office to which the people elected me."

This reply evidently covers the ground, and laps over to the next request of the city council. In classic American, it did the evening up. No one in the aldermanic chamber had any appetite for disputing or even discussing it. No one had any plan for turning the mayor's flanks, "Let it," said the alderman presiding, "be filed." He might have added an epithet, but he did not, we are glad to say. It is still on file, and Mayor Woodward is still at the head of the city government, where he will stay until January 1, despite all bombardments of a resignative nature from the esteemed council.
