## SURE TALLY FOR COINS

Machine That Counts Money  
Invented in Chicago.  
TREMENDOUS SAVING IN LABOR.

Cleven Device Will Relieve Bank Clerks of Bank Pay-Now Being Used in the Subtreasury Building in the Windy City—Inventor in the United States, subsidiary in Chicago—money is being counted by a curious little machine just invented by two Chicago men, says the Chicago Inter Ocean. Fastened to the tables upon which are heaped hundreds of dollars is something that looks not unlike an old-fashioned coffee mill of miniature size. The clerk who for years has counted brain-fag by laboriously whisking two coins at a time off the table with his fingers and keeping track of them in his head now pours the money into a little hopper with one hand, while with the other he turns a crank. A tiny register marks the number of each coin as it passes through the machine and falls into a bag. The clerk is relieved of all responsibility, for he knows that it is impossible for the machine to make a mistake. He could wonder if his work if it would not disturb other clerks who have not yet been so fortunate as to be assigned to the use of a coinometer. The coinometer has been thus christened by employees of the subtreasury who have been testing it for several weeks. They coined a new word to describe a labor-saving device for which they predict great things. They have a special interest in the machine, because it originated in the brain of Captain Thomas I. Porter, head of the secret service department connected with the Chicago subtreasury. Captain Porter has always had what the bankers would call a knack for inventions. Just to amuse himself, he has invented many things, and ingenious little substances which might have made his fortune if he had not been in the line in which he was interested above all other things. Captain Porter has made a reputation in the secret service, and he enjoys the work of his department. When he has a spare moment, free from official cares, he whittles out a model for something that will "do a long felt want." Notwithstanding the fact that very few in the country have his expert class and unusual ideas, his great accuracy and skill in applying and it is a common thing for the subtreasury employees to discover time-consuming and other similar institutions are not counted, and they are often over as under the amounts marked on the bags containing them. This fact set Captain Porter to thinking. In his leisure hours he whittled out a little wooden cylinder just the circumference of a dime. It was long enough to contain 50 dimes, and he had a hole in the cylinder, a turn of the hand opened it, and the coins were allowed to slide through. A crank attached to a register enabled the clerk to mark the number of dimes counted every time the 50 were thrust through the hole. It was at this point that Captain Porter obtained valuable assistance Harry Abbott, to whom he went when he was ready to have a model made. Mr. Abbott is a mechanical engineer and an inventor of more than ordinary genius. He saw where Captain Porter's invention could be developed into a machine that would be practically perfect. The two inventors agreed to work together. The result of the combined brains is the coinometer. The coinometer is made in various sizes, according to the piece of money it is intended to count. At the subtreasury, there are now in operation machines that count dimes, quarters and half dollars. A dollar machine will be put in as soon as it can be made at the machine register factory. The speed of the coinometer is astonishing. While its inventors guarantee that it will count ten pieces a second, it has made a much faster record in many tests. In counting necessary delays for the picking out of damaged coins and other interruptions, a clerk can count \$1,000 in quarters in less than eight minutes when it would require an expert at least an hour to perform the same task. It is thought that the coinometer's power to the machine, so that it is likely that electricity soon will be substituted for the hand power in the coinometer crank. The relief that this machine promises to bank clerks, treasury employees and men engaged in counting money in large business establishments can hardly be estimated.
