EUROPEAN GROWTH.

An official census is being taken this year by the leading European nations. In growth the United States leads Europe, but nearly all the countries of the old world have made good gains. The Chicago Record-Herald makes these comparisons:

"During the last decade the gain in England and Wales has amounted to 12.15, whereas in the preceding ten years it was only 11.65 per cent. Germany's increase was nearly 15 per cent for the decade and 7.79 per cent for the last five years.

"The Italian gain cannot be exactly reckoned for there was no official census between 1881 and 1901. In the period of twenty years the advance was about 22 per cent. At any rate, statisticians were all at sea and guessed two or three million below the true figures. But the percentages for the different countries show approximately: United States 21, Germany 15, England and Wales 12.15, Italy 11. The number of people credited to each is:

United States, including Hawaii and Alaska.....76,295,220
Germany.....56,345,014
Italy.....35,000,000
England and Wales.....32,525,716

If there was no change in Scotland or Ireland the total population of the United Kingdom would now be 41,628,166. But in the decade between 1881 and 1891 there was a loss in Ireland, which exceeded the gain in Scotland. The loss was 470,086, the gain 200,114, leaving a net loss of 179,972.
