## ELECTION OF SENATORS.

For ten years past there has been more or less agitation for the election of United States Senators by a popular vote.

A number of state legislatures have adopted resolutions in favor of the amendment to the constitution to this effect. A still larger number of state political conventions have declared in favor of this plan.

Several bills have been before Congress for the submission of such an amendment but none of them has commanded anything like the support necessary to their passage.

Senator Burrows, of Michigan has branched off in a new direction on this proposition.

He has been impressed by the frequent deadlocks in legislatures over the election of senators and the wrangles in the senate over the question as to whether the governor has the authority to fill a senatorial vacancy after the legislature has failed to elect.

At the next session of Congress Senator Burrows will propose an amendment to the constitution providing that in such a case the governor shall issue a proclamation for a popular election, as in the case of a vacancy in the house of representatives.

It is very desirable that there shall be full representation in the senate.

For months states have been represented by only one member of the senate, and now Delaware is entirely without representation in the senate.

The Burrows amendment will bring to bear upon the legislatures a pressure which would prevent many deadlocks which would otherwise occur.

And when legislatures did fail to elect senators it would be an excellent plan to have a popular election to fill the vacancies.
