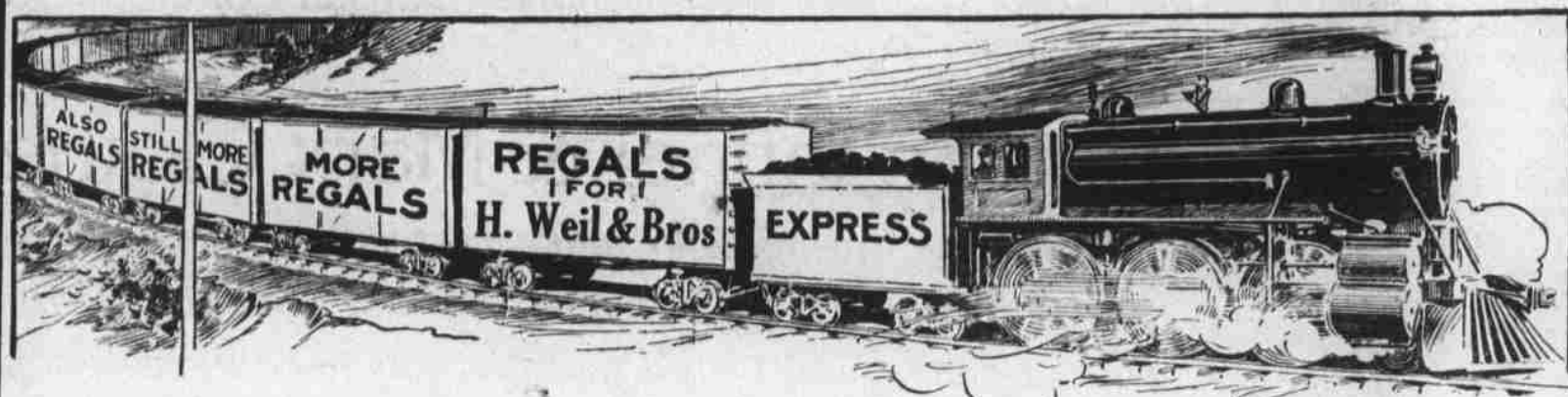

Mr. Southerland was in his store when the death summons came, where friends found him a few moments after he had peacefully passed away.

Mr. Southerland was 60 years of age, and was a brother of our late lamented townsman, Mr. R. J. Southerland, Sr. He was one of Duplin county's most esteemed and respected citizens, and his death will be deeply mourned by his friends throughout this section of the State and elsewhere.
