THE VOICE OF ELKINS.

The voice of Stephen B. Elkins was raised against the monopolistic control of the Senate by the justly celebrated firm of Aldrich, Hale & Lodge, and no one has yet defended that firm or refuted in any manner any of Mr. Elkins' statements. All that he said specimen brick culled from his speech:

He said: You might get permission once a week to move to adjourn perhaps."

"BANQUO" CASTRO.

President Castro was landed, not in Venezuela, but in Martinique, an island belonging to France. This island is a considerable distance from Venezuela. Castro goes to the West Indies avow edly as a revolutionist. He proposes to upset the Goufez government, and then trouble all along the line will begin again.

President Gomez has already setfled all questions in dispute that had arisen between Venezuela and other nations. Even the trouble with Holland has been put in course of adjustment.
