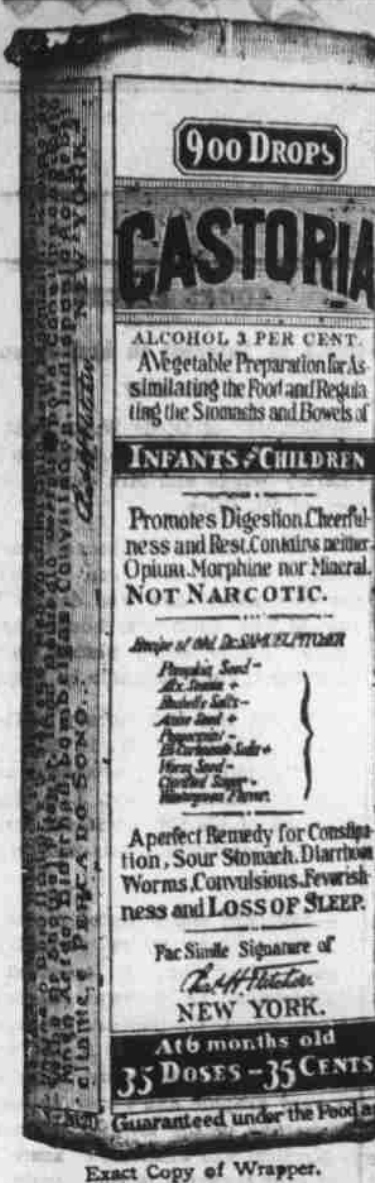

PASSED INTO HISTORY.

The death of Mrs. Hayes, who died at her home in Colorado Springs, from this world the last night of July in the family of Jefferson Davis. She was six years old when her father became the President of the new-born Confederacy, and at the time of her death she was fifty-four years of age. Her sister, Winnie, died in 1898, and four brothers had passed away before her. Jefferson Davis died in New Orleans in 1889, and Mrs. Davis died in New York in 1896.

Mrs. Hayes was the wife of J. Addison Hayes, a banker of Colorado Springs, and she alone of Jefferson Davis' children left children. Two sons and two daughters mourn her death. The elder son has, by legislative permit, taken the name of Jefferson Hayes Davis, and in that way the name of his historic grandfather will be perpetuated. Mrs. Hayes led a quiet home life in Colorado, but she was greatly beloved by all who knew her. Many tributes of affection and regret are being paid to her memory. The funeral was held at Colorado Springs, and the urn will, in the fall, be conveyed to Richmond, where it will be interred by the graves of the other members of the family. "Like her distinguished mother," says Gen. Clement A. Evans, in his official order, "Mrs. Hayes did not enjoy the best of health, and was on this account, denied the pleasure of attending the reunions of the United Confederate Veterans to the same extent as her charming sister, 'Winnie.' Yet she was often able to be present at these annual gatherings, and the 'boys' of the Confederate armies ever greeted her with that hearty affection that they felt for her immortal father. Gifted in mind, charming in manner, winning in behavior, she won the affections of all who knew her intimately. She will long be remembered by all the members of this order."

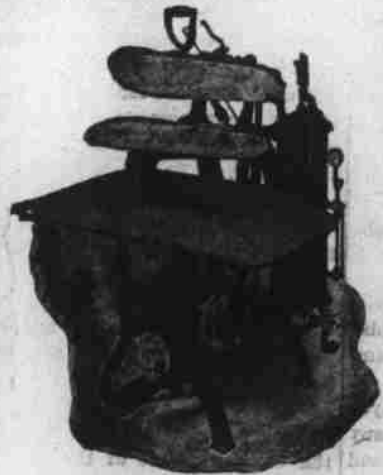

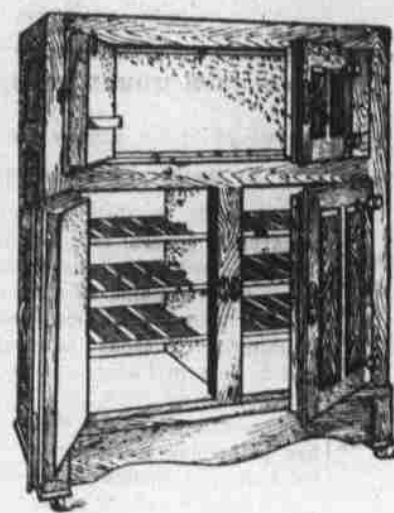
