THE results of Tuesday's election, show a greater Republican victory than the first figures indicated. The Charlotte Observer of Wedesday, says:

At times during the campaign it appeared exceedingly probable that Mr. Bryan would be elected; for the past two weeks it was manifest to the intelligent and caudid observer of events that the election would go to Mr. Taft un less something extraordinary oc curred to turn back the tide which had begun to run in his favor; but at no stage of the campaign, up to its very end, had there appeared anything to fore-shadow the Republican landslide which the returns witness."
