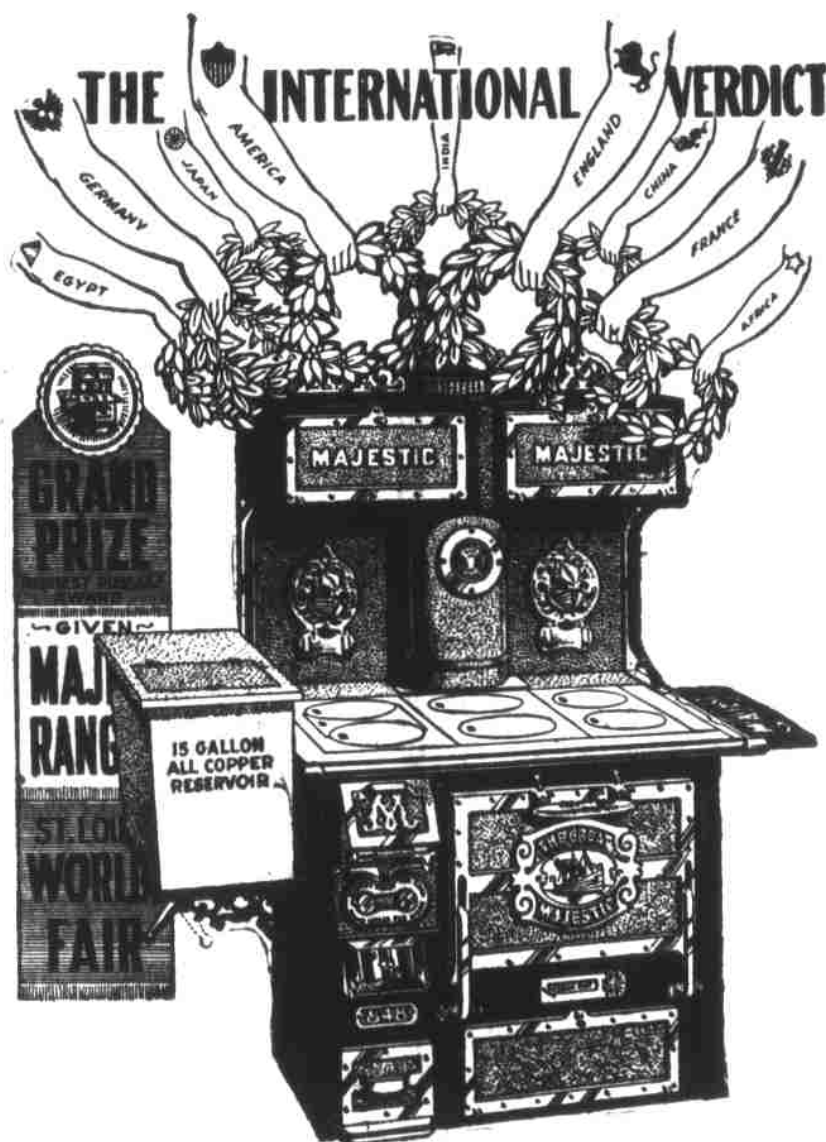

4,000 LAMPS LIT BY WIRELESS

Current Carried Five Miles for Four Hours Without Wires.

Omaha, May 13.—The Omaha Electrical Show was last night lighted by wireless current, this being the first time that a lighting currents has been sent without wires.

The current came from the Government wireless station at Fort Omaha five miles from the auditorium where the show was being held. There were 4,000 incandescent lamps and for four hours those lamps were lighted by the wireless current.

The system by which the experiment was made was a discovery of Dr. Frederick Millner, wireless expert of the Union Pacific Railroad.

The Bill of Lading Fraud.

The extent to which bill of lading frauds have been carried on in this country is something astonishing. It's claimed that they amount to about \$3,000,000 a year. The American Bankers' Association is making an effort to eliminate these frauds through a new form of bill of lading. The boards of trade and commercial exchanges throughout the country have agreed to pay no drafts on bill of lading attached,

unless every bill, in addition to the signature, bear also the official stamp of the authorized agent, such stamp giving date of his signature. All the writing on the bill of lading must be in ink or indelible pencil, and the quantity received for must be written in full in addition to the numerals. It is believed that the adoption of these safeguards will operate to the advantage of all, including the carriers, and very largely tend to avoid further losses through forgery and alterations. While but very little fraud of this kind there has been enough of it to make the matter interesting to our people.

Pencil wood is often taken from old rail fences. Cedar wood, even though rotted and weather beaten without, has singular propensity to remain fresh and sound within and it is thus that many of the pencil makers get their supply of wood.
