Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Pitt County in regular session assembled on the 4th day of October, 1915, it being the regular meeting held on the first Monday in October, 1915, ordered an election to be held in Chicod Township, Pitt County, North Carolina on Tuesday, the 14th day of December, 1915, at Black Jack, the regular Polling Place in Chicod Township, on the question or proposition of issuing Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, worth of road Bonds, to bear five (5) per cent interest per annum, payable semi-annually and to run for a period of Thirty (30) years, the

funds received from the same to be used for the purpose of laying out, establishing, repairing, grading, constructing and improving in any way the Public Roads in Chicod Township as provided by an Act of the Legislature of North Carolina, Session of 1913, designated as Chapter One Hundred and Twenty-two (122), of the Public Laws of North Carolina.
