THE MOST POTENT SPELL. The reports from Raleigh all indicate that what was recognized and known as the "Majority Populist party" to distinguish it from the "Minority Populist party," will soon change places with the latter, in point of numbers.

This division of the Populist party which came about over the Senatorial fight was like nearly every party fight, one which was brought about by factional leaders who were striving for individual power or patronage.

The fight over Senator Patchard, aside from the political principles involved, was one to decide whether Senator Butler should any longer dictate the entire political slate in North Carolina.

In this struggle for supremacy Senator Butler made a great fight, but failed. No party in North Carolina now trembles and asks before it meets in convention or seeks any kind of legislation, "What does Senator Butler think of it?" That time has passed and with it the man who was never content or satisfied, but was continually reaching out to make political conquest, regardless of the feelings or rights of others.

In the last political struggle Senator Butler was at his best. The fight proved that, far he terrorized his followers as only Butler was capable of doing. The "minority" of his party was his ruin. This party was inspired to act as it did by several considerations. It was sick of one man rule. It owed its election largely to its promises of co-operation with the Republicans on the Senatorial matter. It had the promise of political spoils before it.

Taking the positions of these two Populist divisions before and after the Senatorial fight, their study is full of interest.

The fact of the majority holding so closely together under Butler's leadership, and their being so weak in fact as the Senator's personal influence is not over them; that they are slowly going over to the other side, and deserting their fallen leader is only human nature.

Senator Butler has passed as a political dictator. Absence of power, means lack of patronage, and patronage is an all important factor in politics in this day, it is the "binding tie" which draws more firmly than "principles," and is the most potent charm to lead a political party.

With Senator Butler's defeat what also goes his potent spell, the promise of patronage. His day of "divorcing" "principles" has departed, for his record is too well known now to make a fight for "principle."

The passing of Senator Butler, means desertion from his ranks. This is now going on. Office is too potent a spell to resist, and the end of the majority Populist party cannot be far distant.
