CO-OPERATIVE ENTERPRISE NECESSARY. To build up cities it is necessary that co-operation among its people shall exist, not merely a co-operation which has for its beginning and end, "I wish you success in your efforts," but a co-operation which puts up money, enters into the work and stands by the enterprise.

It may be true that a few citizens are the promoters of new enterprises in every city, but the success of their efforts is ever problematical until the rest of the community enter into and second the efforts of the original promoters.

The proposition to start an industry in New Berne by any of its citizens, ought to receive the support of every one who can contribute towards its success, and there are several ways in which this may be done.

The future prosperity of New Berne is going to depend largely upon what industries can be built up and set to providing work for our people, for as the working class are given remunerative labor, so will be the development of everything else, and with such labor for our people the cry of dull times will never be heard, for people will be too intent upon their work to stop to talk or complain.

The Tobacco Warehouse project was started upon this co-operative plan, it is backed by the merchants of the city, and while the actual work of the enterprise is entrusted to a few, yet the company has a strong support which means its success.

But while this Warehouse enterprise has a numerous backing, it ought to be the object of every citizen of New Berne to find it in every possible way, for if this is done its success will not only be assured, but it will be a success and a profitable one, to both the Warehouse people and every business man in it.

Co-operative enterprise is what New Berne wants. Our city is only a large family after all, and what interests and promotes the welfare and prosperity of one citizen, is felt by every other one.

There is not an interest in this city which cannot be affected in some degree, for good or evil, by any citizen, therefore how necessary it is that there so much depends upon mutual support, that support should be always for good.

Make the enterprising spirit of our people co-operative, and there can be no question of the future prosperity of this city and its people.
