STILL UNKNOWN.

The Loaded Cartridge Among Blanks Unaccounted For.

No Supreme Court Session. Farmer Institute a Success. Press Association Goes to Nashville in September. Red Men Organized.

RALEIGH, N. C., July 15.
The killing of Mr. Banks in the sham battle on Tuesday night remains as much a mystery as ever. The flattened bullet that was taken from the man's head weighed only a trifle less than a target bullet, and that was accounted for by the fact that a few grains was taken from the ball in passing through the skull and in cutting it out. It is said the members of the company gathered on all the shells in the armory that were in sight as they started out, of course having no idea they were not all blanks, but if such was allowed it seems to be gross carelessness on the part of the officers for those cartridges should have been examined and issued to one man at a time. Private Banks was given full military burial today.

There will be no special session of the Supreme court. The Governor it is said has no power to call an extra session of the court unless it be to decide a question on the construction of the general election law as provided for in the laws of 1885.
J. W. Mott of Polenta has been appointed by Governor Russell as a delegate to the cotton growers convention at Galveston.

The R. R. commission will next take up the work of equalizing the valuation of property. They were appointed a Board of equalization. There is now no system or regularity in the valuation.

NO REDUCTION.

Commission Decides that Present Rates are Equitable.

The Political Movement Against the Railroads Fails. Decision Based on Population. Attorney General Says School Tax Elections must be Held.

RALEIGH, N. C. July 15.—The Railway Commission decides, after hearing the railway officials and examining the rates, that the passenger rates in North Carolina are lower than in other states in proportion to the population per square mile and that the freight rates are fully as low. It therefore declines to reduce rates.
The State Superintendent of Public Instruction has received a letter from the Attorney General regarding the action of the Craven county commissioners saying that his decision stands that the public school tax election is legal and must be held.

SPECULATORS SELLING.
Congressional Deadlock Caused Selling of Sugar.

Railway Stocks Steady at Advance But Dull. Cotton Higher on Dry Weather. Wheat Receipts Light, Good Foreign Demand.

New York, July 15.—The Congressional dead lock in the Conference at Washington over sugar, caused selling. This is a purely speculative movement and it is hard to determine the outcome.
Tobacco trust recovered on declaration of a dividend and was very strong. Railway stocks were steady at top prices, but dull.
Cotton daily advances on continued dry weather and the advanced prices for spot. The feature was the realizing which caused a slight reaction from the highest prices.
The position for cotton is strong, looks like good prices for new crop.
Continued light receipts and scarcity of the crop of wheat, coupled with the foreign demand were the features in the wheat market.
Farmers are holding their wheat and will undoubtedly get higher prices.

Important ministerial councils were held in Constantinople on Sunday and Monday, at which an indemnity of 6,000,000 pounds were agreed upon as the extreme limit of Turkey's concession.
