## MUST ALL GO.

Remaining Democratic Penitentiary Employees to be ousted.

Theatrical Season Open. Vanderbilt Exhibit at State Fair. Professor Craighill Resigns. Butler Hard on the Minority. Surry County gets the Money.

JOURNAL BUREAU, RALEIGH, N. C., August 18.

The Board of directors of the penitentiary met this afternoon to look to the ousting of all the Democrats who have so far been retained. They were kept there so that all the officers might not be new hands, and the board now thinks it time to change. Superintendent Smith does not think so, and will try to keep them until things are in better running order.

Governor Russell has returned to the Mansion, and will remain here now during the rest of the summer.

Senator Butler passed through here yesterday on his way East from Concord.

The theatrical season was opened here last night with Mackie's "Little Jack Horner." Five shows are booked by the managers of the Academy for the winter.

A. G. Fields opens the season at the Academy on the 28th.

George Vanderbilt's manager has written to Secretary Nichols of the State Fair association for large space in Agricultural Hall and also large space for cattle exhibit at the State Fair in October.

There is every indication that the exhibits will be fine this year in every department.

Yesterday the Atlantic Coast Line paid in the State Treasury \$19,595, and the Seaboard Air Line \$9,208 for railroad taxes for the fiscal year.

Professor W. R. Craighill, professor of the chair of mathematics at the Agricultural and Mechanical college has tendered his resignation to the board. He accepts a position in a northern college.

The board has also received the resignation of Prof. J. M. Johnston who was recently elected assistant professor of Agriculture. These vacancies will have to be filled soon as the fall term will begin September 9th.

Chief of Police Norwood who was suspended some two weeks ago has been re-installed.

A. E. Moye the proposed man for the straight Populist nomination for Congress in the 1st district is clerk of the Pitt county court, and his friends say he should have had the nomination four years.

It is declared that while Senator Butler did not say anything against the minority Populists before the State committee, he scored them afterwards, and the minority are indignant at this.

Dr. R. B. Ellis one of the oldest physicians in Raleigh had a stroke of paralysis this morning.

The Equalization board today finished its work regarding the 76 counties heard from. The remaining 20 will be attended to later on. The board has equalized the values of horses, cattle, etc., and the registrars must make the county tax valuations conform to this. This means considerable increase in the total valuations.

The "Crawford gold mining" company of Stanley has, by permission of the State, changed the name to the "United Gold Fields Corporation." The Gumbock coal mines will not be sold until in October instead of September 6th.

Surry county gets the \$500 offered by Julian S. Carr to the county who had the most townships that voted for the special school tax. That county was the only one in which more than one township voted for the tax.

Fastest Battle Ship Afloat.

WASHINGTON, D. C., August 17.—Officers of the Navy Department were much interested today in the trial trip of the Yamahina, the new Japanese battleship built in England. She is the fastest battle-ship afloat, and it is claimed from the showing made in her trial trip that she is one of the greatest fighting machines ever built.

She is 372 feet long with 73 feet beam and 26.3 feet draft and has 15,400 tons displacement. Under 11-2 air pressure for four hours she made 19.23 knots and for a single hour 19.46 knots.

Tires Punctured.

MILWAUKEE, Wis., Aug. 17.—About 200 bicycle riders who took a spin into the country for pleasure had to walk back to the city today, a distance of seven or eight miles, owing to punctures.

Some one buried a plank filled full of spikes in the bicycle path on the Cedarburg road, between Maquon and Thiensville, and succeeded in disabling two hundred wheels before the cause of disaster was discovered. The route is a favorite one with wheelmen.

Another plank was discovered buried on Ninth street road, near the city limits.

Latest News Items.

The revenue cutters Boutwell and Morrill are watching for Cuban filibusters off Southern Florida.

Three hundred and ten thousand dollars in gold was received from Havana by New York bankers.

Secretary Sherman, denying a report that he had offered President McKinley his resignation, said that there was no occasion for him to do so, since he was contented in his position and President McKinley was satisfied with his work. He said President McKinley had taken occasion to express his satisfaction in a recent letter to him.

James S. Parsons, the fugitive president of the Continental Life Insurance Company, has returned after ten years a penniless man, to die here at home.

His defalcations, in 1887, amounted to between \$100,000 and \$150,000, and he has returned just after the payment by the receivers of his defunct company of a total of 16 per cent. realized on its assets, or \$125,000 to creditors.

The Morgan Line steamer El Rio, Captain Quick, which arrived Monday from New Orleans, made the passage from bar to bar in 3 days 20 hours, and 37 minutes, being the fastest on record, and lowering her best previous time by two hours.

At the Government works on Tybee Island an engine pushing a flat car up an inclined plane could not be stopped, and the car was plunged over the chute. Six men were precipitated 29 feet. Five may die.

It is rumored that the death at Tehran Persia, of Dr. Tholozan, the physician of the late Shah, was caused by poison administered at the instigation of the reigning Shah, because Tholozan knew too many state secrets.

The United States Board of Naval Officers appointed to investigate the subject has arrived at Bethlehem on a visit to the big plant of the Bethlehem Iron Company. It is the Board's purpose to ascertain the truth of the Bethlehem and Carnegie Companies' statement that they cannot afford to furnish armor for battleships at the Government price of \$300 a ton.

Spurious Bonds.

WASHINGTON, August 17.—There were presented to the Treasury Department today for redemption two \$1,000 7-30 notes of the issue of June 15, 1863. The persons making the presentation were business men of Louisville, Ky. Upon examination the notes were found to be counterfeit, being a part of a very large issue of counterfeit notes which appeared in the principal bond markets in 1865 and 1867.

The imitation of the genuine is so complete that many of the principal dealers in United States securities purchased them freely, and only discovered that they had been victimized when the notes were thrown out by the authorities at Washington.
