In the establishment of Courts of Arbitration by law, precisely like courts of equity, there must be some infringement upon individual rights and possibly so much of an infringement as to place the establishment of such courts out of the question.

However this may be, will it not be better that some personal liberty be given up, if by the surrender of individual privileges, the welfare of the State and Nation be best served, and there be a cessation of strife between Capital and Labor?




