tates that he is using his artillery today and firing upon the Spanish intrenchnents and the forts. General Shafter has nearly fifty siege guns and a larger number of seven-inch mortars, besides ighter artillery. The authorities at Washington are

hourly expecting news of the fall of the city. General Shafter for his part is confident of getting possession within three General Shafter states that his lines are

well thrown out, covering a frontage of five miles, and in an impregnable condition. The American forces do not completely surround the city and many of the Spanish troops may escape from the city through the passes to the westward. Many of them may retreat during the night and get back toward the troops now approaching from Manzanillo,
