Material development advanced; ad vancement of every child who wishes an education regardless of the financial ability of its parents; competent and good tuition at a low cost; unity of pen ple and development of local industrie the intellectal life of the community quickened and broadened.

These briefly stated are some of the effects of Graded Schools in Goldsboro, as Supt. Foust outlines.

Schools here? Does not this community lack in these Schools, and with an increase of tax, a

most insignificant one? The lack of school facilities is the greatest obstacle to the progress of any community, for no family will move into a city which has no school facilities, and it to known for a fact that families will leave such a community.


