The insurance commissioner has issue he following: "This Department desires to call you attention to the provisions of "an act to provide for the investigation of incenliary fires," chapter 58, laws of 1896

Under this act ft is made the duty of the asurance commissioner to examine, or cause examination to be made, into the use, circumstances and origin of fire within the State, whenever in his judg ment the evidence is sufficient, as well a to supervise and direct such investiga-tions made by other officers charged with this duty, whenever he deems it expedient or necessary. And the opmmission or desires by this circular letter to cal he attention of the officers and citizen to this law, and sak of them their hearty co-operation and best aid in carryllag out its provisions. The proper enforcement of this law will secure the punishment of caraless and wilful destroyers of property in the State, which will result in no only greater security for the lives and property of our citizens, but a safer in-surance protection at better rates.
