WILL THE NEGRO EVER LEARN?

The question can be seriously asked will the Southern negro ever learn, and profit by, that his home and friends are in the Southland?

A few months ago the family of Bakers, colored, who lived at Lake City, S. C., were rescued (by) certain Bostonians, inspired and animated by a mendacious sentiment, and carried to Boston.

Naturally the Bakers must have regarded such a removal as one which meant ease and plenty for them for the rest of their lives.

Soon after the family reached Boston, the nation's seat of cranks and faddists, the newspaper reports told of their public exhibitions, which judging from all accounts were of the dullest variety character.

But the Bostonians soon tired of the novelty, with the result that it became a matter of disagreement among the so-called rescuers of the negroes, as to who should pay for their sustenance, the exhibitions having failed as revenue producers.

The story now is that an appeal is being made by the Bakers a home, and the New England public is asked to contribute, the great sum of \$1,500 being fixed as the necessary amount needed for the purpose.

Last year through the election excitement at Wilmington, N. C., which ended in the riot, caused by the negroes, there started a negro exodus from that city to the northern States, and several thousand negroes left for new homes.

While no doubt some of those who left, have and are doing well in the north very many of them are looking towards the south and seeking to return.

Those negroes who left the South for new homes are not finding the North such a Land of Promise as they had at easy times and plenty of physical comforts.

They find in the North that they must work, and that neither their new professions are mediums for food and "salmon," and very different in the climate, with months of snow and cold weather, from the few weeks of a southern winter, where it is easy to keep fairly warm, and food can be produced by a little labor.

It is a hard lesson for the negro to learn, and those who have tried it have experienced hardships, but these experiences have brought them to a sense of discovering who are their friends, and where it is best for them to live, south or north.

The negro who has sought the North has soon discovered that his betterment demanded labor and continued effort, and his personal liberty and enjoyment depended, as it did in the south, upon his individual conduct and good behavior, and his freedom was of a kind which made him long to get back again to the Southland, where his restricted freedom was more imaginary than real.

However all this changing about of the negro may result, it ought to teach him to recognize who his real friends are, and also that his future will be best advanced when he depends upon his own efforts and not upon others.
