Insurance Against Strikes.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 5 - A number of Austrian manufacturers have formed an association for insurance against strikes. according to United States Consul Hoss feld, at Trieste. It is the object of the association to indemnify its several members for all losses sustained by them from unjust strikes which may break out in their respective establish ments. Each member is to pay a weekly premium equal to from 3 to 4 per cent of the amount of his pay roll. When a strike occurs, a committee will be appointed to investigate all the circum stances, and if the cause of the strikers be found just no indemnity shall be


