RALEIGH.

New Court Districts Give General Satisfaction to the People.

Committee on Public School Law. Amount Available by Pension Tax. Railway Trackage Tax Would Yield \$25,000.

RALEIGH, February 12.—The joint legislative committee on education is at work on the public school law. One of the questions under special consideration is whether there shall be one school committee or three, or whether there shall be a township committee.

The Biblical Recorder has occupied news quarters here. It is now owned by a stock company. J. William Baily continues to be editor.

There is great and general satisfaction at the passage of the bill increasing the Superior Court districts from 12 to 16 and abolishing the two criminal courts; also at the passage of the bill taking all compensation to judges for holding special terms—save alone their actual necessary expenses, which the county asking for the special term must bear.

CUBA'S OLD DEBTS.

Convention Does Not Favor Paying Them Recent Obligations.

Havana, Feb. 11.—Cuba will decline responsibility for all old debts, if the action taken by the Constitutional Convention be ultimately ratified. Senor Llerenas said that Cuba should pay the United States for the cost of the war before attempting to pay the army.

The first clause of the Twenty-fifth section, which declares that Cuba will not be responsible for debts contracted prior to the promulgation of the Constitution and as contracted for legitimate expenses of the revolution after February 24, 1895 was not changed.

Man who Shot Chief Justice.

Jesse D. Beale, who figures conspicuously in a sensational shooting in Montgomery, Alabama in which he shot the Chief Justice of the State, lived in this city as a boy. The Beale family were well known here and are remembered by many.

Chief Justice McLennan was shot in the shoulder by Beale. The trouble was over a family matter and has been adjusted. All concerned were people of prominence.
