NEW CITIZENS.

Coming In From Other States But Few Are Foreigners.

New Laws Printed By July 1st. The Usual Unfortunate Mistakes By Legislatures. Cotton Still On Hand.

RALEIGH, April 20.—The State commissioner of immigration informs me that during the past four years more than ten thousand persons from other States have settled in North Carolina. He says that hardly any foreigners have come; that in fact the latter do not come South; that they go west, their movements being really directed by the great steamship and railway companies. He says a very desirable class of people is coming here.

Mr. Hackett, who is indexing the acts of the last legislature says he does not think the laws will appear until after July 1. The public printers are, by the terms of an act of 1901, given three months from the time of the awarding of the printing contract to deliver the laws.

There are some awkward errors in some of the acts, this being notably the case with the one requiring the non-indigent insane in the hospitals to pay for their maintenance etc. Grammatical errors mixing of sentences and superfluous as well as omitted words, make it very ambiguous. The attorney general is looking into the matter, to see how it shall be construed.

It is stated that the convict in the penitentiary refused to work one day this week. A Raleigh convict, serving a life term, had told that the new warden, Mr. Fleming, would inflict cruel punishments. It is said that one or two persons had aided in spreading this rumor. Chairman Travis, of the directorate, quoted the ineffectual rebellion, by telling the convicts the story was baseless.

The chairman of the penitentiary board left for the east to arrange a contract for furnishing forty convicts to work at a saw mill and in cutting timber.

Another fraternal insurance company has entered the State. It is devoted to the insurance of the Old Fellows solely. It is quite odd to go out in the country and see the vast preparations for planting cotton and yet see cotton of the last crop stored away at the home of the farmer. It would be really interesting to know how many bales are thus stored in Wake. It is said that in the little county of Pitt there are 5,000 bales.

Lands are dearer this season than four correspond has ever seen them here, and there is a notably large reclamation of long-disused lands.

PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

The Extra Appropriation Not Available Until End of Year.

Interest in Education Greater Than Ever Known. Figures on Expenditures for Twenty Years For Each Race.

RALEIGH, April 20.—This year \$100,000 from the State treasury, of a current appropriation, will be available for the public schools whenever called for. Another \$100,000 was appropriated this year, to bring the school terms up to not less than 4 months, but this will not be available until the taxes for this year are collected, which means the end of the year.

There is great interest in public education now; far greater than ever before in this State. Gov. Aycock says last year's political campaign was really an educational one.

At the office of the superintendent of public instruction it is learned that during the past 20 years this State has expended \$7,810,964 for white and \$1,091,129 for negro public schools. It also spent \$8,832,964 for general expenses for both races, of which the whites got the benefit of 66 and the negroes of 44 per cent. The total expended was \$15,735,000. The negroes pay 5 per cent of the taxes.

A special man will be placed in charge of it and all mail arriving for visitors of the Reunion or members of the different commands of Confederate Veterans or Sons of Veterans will be delivered to the hall, will be there assorted and arranged for delivery, and any visitor expecting a letter from home can find it at headquarters. Confederate Hall itself is in rapid progress.
