REQUIRE CARE.

Penitentiary Matters Demand Business Methods to Pull Through.

Text Book Commission Show. Small Pox in Wake County. Chemical Society Meet. Weddings Are Expected.

RALPHON, April 27.--It will require admirable management to carry the penitentiary through this year without a call for aid. The new directors are applying themselves zealously to this task and also to the duty of selecting a superintendent who fits in the best sense of the word a business man.

Your correspondent had an interesting interview with that excellent business man, Captain N. O. Berry, of Goldsboro, one of the new directors of the penitentiary. Captain O'Berry said: "I have today completed the work of going over the books and accounts, inventory, etc., of the penitentiary and have made a full report to the Governor. Here is what I find: Assets \$76,000; debts, \$40,000; available net assets, \$36,000. This is \$38,000 less than W. H. Day's report for January as superintendent showed."
