All reports indicate that the past week has been very favorable both for farm work and for the growth of crops. The temperature averaged about normal and the days were generally warm without extremes, but cool nights prevailed toward the close of the week. The light showers which were quite general about the 6ht or 7th were very beneficial, softening the soil which had begun to be hard to work. The amount of sunshine was abundant. Farmers took advantage of these favorable conditions to push Ribs:work as much as possible; many fields have been cleaned of grass and are well cultivated, but the amount of work to be done was so great that grass has not all been subdued, and another week of fair. weather is required. Crops still average from two to three weeks late, but have made considerable growth and renewed
