INDICATOR OF BUSINESS AND PROSPERITY.

It is generally accepted that the sale of postage stamps is a good indicator of the amount of business done in a place.

Just at present the postage stamp need not be used as pointing to prosperity throughout the country, for other evidences are sufficient. Take the sale of postage stamps in New Bern, the continual increase indicates that the business conditions here are improving.

From the figures obtained at Washington a correspondent of The St. Louis Globe-Democrat learns that in 1881 the sales of stamps amounted to 67 cents per inhabitant in 1890 to 95 cents and in 1901 to \$1.35.

The comparison is not carried back of 1881, because previous to that year letter postage was 50 per cent. higher than in 1900, and the maximum weight for a single rate of postage was only one-half what it is at the present time.

From the above figures it is easy to see that prosperous years have increased sales of postage stamps. The postage stamp may be a small affair, but it is a factor in the trade situation and a good barometer of business conditions of a city.
