## RALEIGH.

### Two Virginians Who are Inspecting N. C. Soil Test Farms.

Leaving for Wrightsville, Esopus Lodge in Pitt County, New Arrivals at Penitentiary Still More Rare.

RALEIGH, Aug. 14.—Commissioner of Agriculture Kester of Virginia and Mr. S. B. Holges, who is in charge of the newly established soil test farm of the State in Charlotte county, spent today here, inspecting the Museum and the experiment farm, the Agricultural College, etc. They have been to the large nurseries and orchards at Pomona, Guilford county, and from here go to Southern Pine to see the experiment farm, orchard, and vine yards. It is possible that they will go the soil test farm near Weldon. They are making a study of test and experiment farms.

Gen. Thomas E. Toon, State Superintendent of public instruction, and Maj. B. F. Dixon, State Auditor, left today for Wrightsville, to be at the encampment of Confederate veterans which began there this afternoon. The local camp here will not be represented, not will the soldiers' home. Gen. Ray of the U. S. V. arrived from Asheville today and went to Wrightsville.

The Grand Master of Masons today issued a dispensation for a new lodge at Farmville, Pitt county.

Sheriff Sittie of the County of Cleveland today brought to the penitentiary Ambrose Bridger, a white man convicted of barn burning, and under a five years sentence, also two negro house breakers, who got away. Convicts arrive at the penitentiary in very small numbers. There are now only 700 State convicts against 8000 twenty years ago. The counties are using them on roads. Only life-term and feeble convicts and women are now sent to the penitentiary from about two-thirds of the counties in other counties take many from counties which are not using them on roads.

There was more rain last night and this morning. Since Monday afternoon 2.85 inches have fallen. None was needed.

### Easy Way to Make \$30,000.

Chicago, August 15.—A morning paper says one of the Chicago banks was swindled out of \$30,000 in cash in a skilful manner. An effort is being made to keep the matter secret and not even the name of the bank is given.

It seems that a depositor of several years' standing appeared a few days ago in the bank president's office with a draft on London for \$30,000 (\$30,000), which was perfectly good. The depositor informed the president that he desired to deposit this London draft, and at the same time to check against it, presenting his check for \$30,000 for the president to approve. The latter put his initials on it and thought nothing of it.

The depositor then went out into the bank and deposited his London draft, and on the following day presented a check for \$30,000, which was paid, the latter knowing that amount was to be credited to the bank. Later in the day he again appeared at the window and presented the check for \$30,000 which had been initialed by the president. This check was also paid. Nothing more has been seen of the depositor.

## THE SWANBORO RAILROAD.

### Visitor Give Some Facts Bearing on This Much Needed Enterprise.

Swanboro, Aug. 14.—There has been much talk among our business men and others, about building a branch road from the Wilmington and New Bern division of the Atlantic Coast Line at or near White Oak station to Swanboro.

We all know it takes money to build rail roads and those who have it must be thoroughly convinced of a good interest or dividends before investing.

In view of these facts, we have endeavored to obtain an accurate statement of the production, fish, oysters, clams and etc. for shipment from this point annually.

We have also a statement of the logs, which would come here over this line for manufacture together with the amount paid out annually on general merchandises by the merchants, the aggregate being more than twenty thousand dollars per year, this would of course increase with the development of the country and the growth of the other different enterprises of the place.

While we do not know anything about building rail roads, yet common sense tells me that this road can be built, below the average cost, as the country through which it would run is almost entirely level, and without cuts and ditches, bridges or trestles, in fact there is nothing to do but cut right of way, make road bed, lay the cross ties and spike down the rails, and we think according to best information obtainable, the road can be completed for sixty-five thousand dollars.

We have endeavored to get a true statement and think our figures are correct which clearly shows the enterprise would pay a large interest, and we are surprised that the citizens have so long neglected to take hold of it.

Aside from freights we have said nothing of the passenger traffic, which would doubtless be a considerable item, as the town would then be prominent among the summer and winter resorts.

Swanboro is beautifully situated on a high bluff on the White Oak river about two miles above the inlet and within plain view of the ocean, making it one of the most pleasant resorts to be found in Eastern North Carolina. It is also unsurpassed as a winter resort, there being fine duck shooting, deer and other game.

It seems to us that some of the enterprising business men of the place would get together and organize a stock company and build the road.
