Disaster in Philippines.

Manila, Sept. 29.—A disastrous fight between United States troops and Filipino revolutionists took place yesterday at Balangiga, on the island of Samar.

A large body of Filipinos attacked Company C, of the Ninth Infantry, killing 49 and wounding 11. The company was at breakfast when attacked and made a determined resistance, but the natives were in overwhelming numbers.

The 24 survivors have arrived at Bassey. They include the 11 wounded. The strength of the company was 73. Captain Edwin V. Bookmiller, of the Ninth Infantry, reports that General Hughes is assembling a force to attack the natives. The latter captured all the stores and ammunition of the company and all its rifles except 13.
