SATURDAY'S LEGISLATURE. More Important Bills. Halls Already Need Renovating. Adjourning Until Tuesday. Special to Journal. Raleigh, January 17--In the Senate a bill was introduced giving Confederate soldiers who served ninety days, \$30 widows of such \$15. Bills passed changing time holding Lenoir courts and amending the road laws of Craven county. In the House, bill was introduced providing pay for oyster inspectors. Bills passed authorizing expenditure of not exceeding \$9,800 for renovating, ventilating, heating the halls of the Legislature. Bill against granting charters by Legislature to any corporation which could obtain same under the general law. Bill requiring committee on penal institutions to investigate the charges of cruelty to convicts at Camp road in Jones county; allowing Bladen county to levy a special tax for new jail. Prohibiting sale, manufacture and importation of liquors into Scotland county. Enabling Onslow county commissioners to use surplus tax; appointing additional justices for Bladen county; one additional commissioner for Greene county; repealing law forbidding ditch nets in the Tar and Pamlico rivers. Adjourning to Tuesday, in honor Lee's birthday and to have halls renovated.
