The barges above named and nine others beldug to F F Munn & Co., of Philadelphia, extensive lumber dealers. New Bern and Washington are the principal lumber supply depots of this com-pany and their boats come here regular-ly. They also visit other ports in this

These barges are not built on lines beauty nor are they meant for pleasure boats but they are strongly and substantially built and when loaded bear an enormous lot of lumber. Their capacities vary from 200,000 to 400,000 feet.

The Atlas is the most recent addi to this line of boats and it is about the same size as its companion boats. It takes its first load from New Bern next
