Reports of the storm Saturday say that the wind blew at the rate of 72 miles an hour at Cape Hatteras.

The League of American Municipalities which was in session at Baltimore last week closed Friday. James H. Reed Mayor of Nashville, Tenn., was elected president.

Indications of a war between Russia and Japan are becoming more apparent. Russia is strengthening fortifications in Manchuria.

Great fear is expressed over the safety of a reservoir at Paterson, N. J., which is in danger of breaking and flooding the city. Millions of dollars worth of property are endangered.

The Honorable Artillery, a military organization of London, composed of wealthy people is touring in this country. They were given a reception at the White House Saturday. The Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company of Boston, and the Minute Men of Washington were also guests.

### IMPORTANT TO FARMERS.

Farmers Convention at Raleigh, October 21st.

All cotton growers and other persons interested in the price of cotton are requested to meet in the House of Representatives in the State Capitol Wednesday evening October 21st at 7:30 o'clock.

Every indication points to a short cotton crop, one much below the requirements of the trade. There is no reason why every farmer should not get good prices for his cotton this season. Let every cotton grower in this State be represented in this meeting and co-operate for a minimum price of ten cents a pound. The following letter from Mr. Harris Jordan explains the situation in the cotton growing States. Many think the present cotton crop should bring 12 1/2 cents a pound. The Commissioner of Agriculture of the cotton growing States in their meeting last week estimated the crop to be only 10,000,000 bales, which is a short crop and should command good prices. Let this meeting be largely attended by cotton farmers so that definite steps can be taken looking toward better prices. Be sure low rates by buying tickets to the Fair.

Mr. T. B. Parker, Sen., Raleigh, N. C. My dear Sir--I am just in receipt of your favor of the 2nd inst, and you voice my views exactly. For the past month I have been an active campaign throughout the south advocating higher prices for our great staple crop, placing the minimum price at which it should be sold at 10 cents per pound. I should be pleased to have your better cooperation in this matter. Cotton is much too low at the present time, and the depression is largely due to the rush of the raw material on the markets by the producers. The crop will be a short one. There will not be enough cotton made to last the mills for another twelve months, and those who hold and market slowly will get the cream of better prices later on. ### IMPORTANT CHARTER

Granted Henderson Company To Operate Telegraph Lines.

Public School Interest at Southport. Raleigh Dispensary Election Holds Masonic Fair. Inmate Soldiers Home Wanders away.

**RALEIGH, Oct. 13.**--The State today granted a charter to the Home Telephone and Telegraph Company, of Henderson. The authorized capital stock is \$200,000 of which \$91,750 is already subscribed. The largest stockholders are W. T. Geary of Aidsite, who has 3117 shares and J. P. Taylor of Henderson, who has 2115 shares. The company is given authority to build, buy, absorb, etc. lines in Henderson, in Vance county, all over North Carolina and in other States, to hold rights and franchises of other companies and to consolidate with them. In other words the purpose of the company is to make a great combination of telephones and possibly telegraph lines. One of the stockholders is F. O. Tooleman of Henderson, who is so prominently connected with the Intrastate Telephone company. The instructions of the department of public instruction has returned from Southport where he did some work in the interest of public school developments. The citizens have raised money to complete the public school and will vote a local tax in aid of the same.

The Anti-Saloon League smiles at the news, first given in this correspondence, that the liquor dealers association intends to fight the dispensary election held here a week ago. They say that the liquor men can do nothing; that the election was in all respects lawful and proper and the result decisive.

The great masonic fair, in aid of the Temple fund, began this evening in the beautifully decorated halls on the lower floor of the agricultural building. Governor was expected to open the fair, but was unable to be present, as he and all the State Officers except Treasurer Lacy went to Greensboro this morning to attend the reunion of non-resident North Carolinians. State Treasurer Lacy was not well enough to attend.

Governor Aycock will go from Greensboro to Mooreville in Iredell county, where he will deliver an address. Leaving there he will pass through here going directly to Norfolk, where he speaks Thursday night at the great meeting of business men in aid of the Jamestown exposition project.

President Spencer, Vice President Andrews, and the board of directors of the Southern railway passed here today on their way to Norfolk on a tour of inspection. It was their desire to stop and pay their respects to the Governor this morning but they found that he could not be in Raleigh, and so telegraphed their regrets at not being able to see him.

An inmate of the soldiers home here, named Pickett, from Orange county, wandered away last Friday and nothing has since been heard of him. It is thought that he is stopping with some farmer in the section. He has a strange delusion that a great many people are after him with intent to kill him.
