## PLANS OF REPUBLICANS.

State Republican Rollins Thinks Party's Future is Bright.

Asheville Gazette, News, Oct. 19th.

Thomas S. Rollins, chairman of the Republican state executive committee, today gave the press the following statement regarding the political situation in North Carolina. He said:

"We intend to make a bold, aggressive campaign next fall, and I am now at work securing the names and addresses of the local committees throughout the State, with a view of making a thorough and complete organization in each county. The people of the State are disgusted with the extravagance of the last Legislature, the high, burdensome and oppressive taxation, and they will no longer rally to the support of the Democratic machine, which alone is responsible for this condition of affairs. Besides, next year is presidential election, and that fact will greatly strengthen our party in this State. Thousands of business men in North Carolina voted for McKinley and Hobart, because they had confidence in the principles advocated by them, and you will find that Roosevelt and Fairbanks are equally as strong and equally as popular. It seems to me that the race problem in North Carolina is practically settled. The great bulk of the colored voters were disfranchised by the adoption of the amendment in August 1900, and they appear to have settled down and become reconciled to the situation."
