RICH PICKING

That of Pick Pockets at State Fair. At the Law Violators. Death.

Raleigh, Oct. 28.—A bar-keeper here, when asked the flat question whether the saloon men intended to fight the dispensary election held here recently, replied that he had made all sorts of inquiries and could not find that any saloon was to be brought to test the election and the State law.

The game warden of this county is after violators of the Audubon law and of the general game law. He has secured within the past three days three convictions of persons killing turkeys, and there is another case to be heard. There is plenty of game and the outlook for a good shooting season is very fine indeed.

Mrs. B. G. Ryan died at her home here last night. She was a daughter of the late Rev. Dr. B. B. Mason, who was for a great many years Rector of Christ Church here. Mr. Ryan is a well known Raleigh lawyer. His wife had been an invalid for a number of years.

The solicitor of this district says no one will ever know the number of persons whose pockets were picked during the State Fair here last week. The gang of pick-pockets was the largest and most daring ever in North Carolina. The solicitor says the aggregate of the thefts is a way up in the thousands of dollars, and that a great many persons have not admitted being robbed.

Quick Conviction and Sentence.

RALEIGH, Oct. 28.—Sheriff Jones of Hertford county today brought to the penitentiary Henry Galling, colored, aged about 18, convicted of attempted felonious assault upon a married woman and is under a ten years sentence.

During the absence of her husband he went to her house and attempted to assault, but she secured a gun and on examining it to see if it was loaded the shells fell out and she did not know how to replace them, otherwise she would have killed him. He was caught that night and was convicted and sentenced in one hour from the time the case went to the grand jury.

Saloon Strong Hold.

RALEIGH, Oct. 28.—Speaking about the election on the liquor question at Kingston yesterday, which resulted in a victory for the dispensary, a Raleigh lawyer of prominence said today that when Wilmington and Weldon voted whiskey out, they indeed he would believe that the saloons were on their last legs.

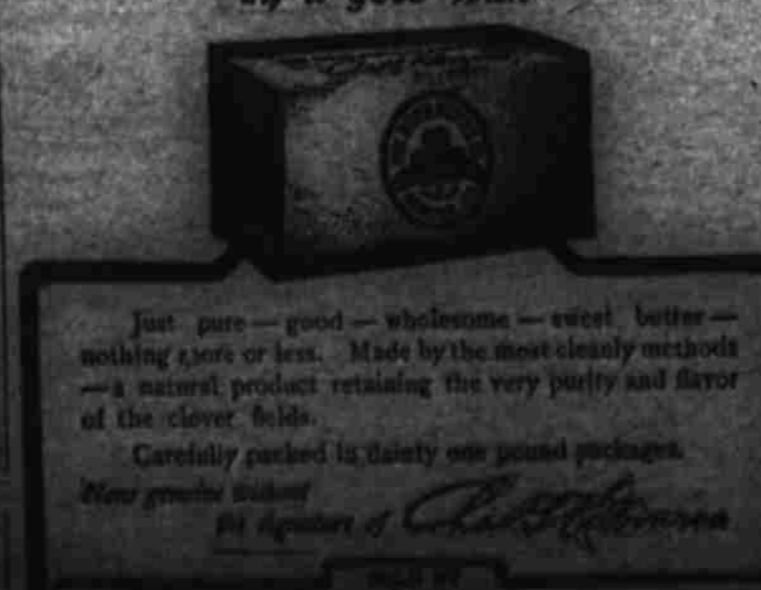

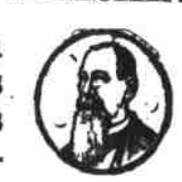

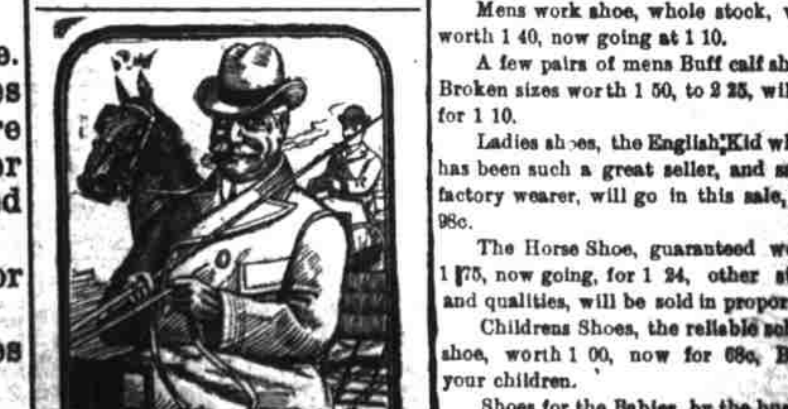
