RALEIGH.

Spring Term Supreme Court Convened. Powell Alleged Fraud Suit, Dangerous Cattle Insect.

Raleigh, Feb. 1.—The Spring term of the Supreme Court began today and cases from the first district will be called tomorrow. Today was devoted to the examination of applicants for license as attorneys. Of these there are forty three. Of these sixteen are from the law school of the State University, fifteen from Wake Forest College, three from that of Shaw University at Raleigh, (colored) one from Howard University, (colored) at Washington, D. C., and one colored who studied at Oxford, N. C. This morning the trial of J. B. Powell, the N. C. fruit insect charged with fraud through misdeeds, as begun by United States Circuit Court, John Nichols. The hearing was held in the Federal Court room, there being many witnesses. It is stated that one of the shipments of goods which was made to Powell at Norfolk from here was not marked "Jones & Powell" but "Powell & Jones" among the witnesses J. A. Jones and A. M. Powell, composing the Raleigh firm of Jones & Powell. Mr. Powell being also the mayor of Raleigh. The State Veterinarian is receiving a number of inquiries as to the insect known by the farmers as the "Wolf" which is the larval form of the injury which is doing considerable injury to cattle.
