WAR UNDOUBTEDLY BEGUN.

Diplomatic Relations Between Russia and Japan Have Ceased.

Tokio, Feb. 7.—The severance of diplomatic relations between Russia and Japan appears to be only a step towards war, although when the ministers of Russia and Japan withdrew from their respective posts quick and decisive action is expected.

On Monday Japan unquestionably will seize Corea, and although Russia has previously intimated that it would not interfere, in view of that country's present attitude, developments are eagerly awaited.
