Heavy Losses Report ed. Russians Lose More Ships. Doubt of Result of Land Battle. Fighting on the Yalu River.

London, February 11.-- War against Russia is being pushed by the Japanes around Port Arthur and on the Yalu river which divides Korea from Manchu ria. Twenty Japanese transports yester day attempted to land troops between Port Arthur and Dalny. The troop ships were convoyed by six Japanes warships. Landings were attempted at several points while the remainder of the Japanese feet kept up a bombard ment of the harbor.

The landing was repulsed by the Rus sian artillery supported by the Siberian rifles. The fighting lasted for two hours and the loss in killed and wounded on both sides was very heavy.


