It needs no confession of ignorance when such statements as these are made. Such statements however reach people who may see no other explanations, so they are deceived, and join the cry, and andorse the Receivership outrage, with out thought of what such a precedent. if it can be established, means in the fu-

As for being "stagnant, dormant or dry rotted," the Atlantic and North Carline railroad is today as active and progressive a railroad property as can be found in the State, and proportionately will show a business increase equal to the best.

The attack made upon President James A Bryan, which reflects equally upon Governor Avcock and the stockholders of the road, that he has not paid a dividend upon the stock during his administration, appears to be an argument for endorsing the Receivership act forced through a single stockholder and he a non-resident.


