FULL INSURANCE AND LESS PREMIUMS

Besides the really added better protection which a paid Fire Department would give the owners of perishable property in New Bern, there is the double advantage which comes to those insuring, that of being able to obtain full insurance upon their property, as well as the least cost of premiums which would have to be paid for insurance.

Under the present Fire Department service in New Bern, no insurer can obtain insurance on his property for over three fourths its valuation. Every householder, the owner of buildings, or merchants who have large stocks of perishable goods, can understand and appreciate the effect of this rule, which the insurance companies have adopted for their protection, under the volunteer fire service which is given this city.

Owners of perishable property insure their property in order to secure themselves against a loss which they cannot absolutely guard against. Every insurer wants, first, the pecuniary protection which first class fire insurance guarantees, and second, if a fire loss occurs, the insurer desires simply to be made good by his insurance, for the actual loss inflicted.

Under the present Fire Department service, the insurer in New Bern must lose, if his property is destroyed, one quarter of it. And to secure even three quarters protection, it costs a much higher proportional premium rate, than it would cost with a paid Fire Department service.

This city has outgrown in every way its present volunteer fire service. This is recognized on all sides. Other cities in this State, notably Greensboro and Asheville, are seeing the same situation in their cities, and seeking to adopt up-to-date methods, which can only be found in a paid fire service.

This paid Fire Department service for New Bern, can be easily adopted. There are no violent charges to be made, no changes involving special expense upon taxpayers. Whatever expense may be found in the change will prove much less tax upon the taxpayer than if the present system be continued, and the high fire premium is to be paid and the three quarters loss clause in insurance policies, is the best insurers can get for protection.

This is a matter demanding attention. Every property owner and merchant has a vital interest in this question. There should be immediate action taken in the matter.
